DEFINITION OF MUSICAL

<u>Musical</u> is a type of theater, which includes beautiful, scary or even comic music and dialogues that are synchronized with the rhythm. One could say that the musical is a more interactive opera. In contrast, however, the musical covers literally all subjects, whether it covers love and joy, or covers terror and agony.



THE HISTORY OF MUSICAL AND THE GOLDEN AGE

The musical was created in the 19th century. Although inspired by ancient representations, it reached its present form in the 19th century, and developed mainly in Britain with the works of Gilbert and Sullivan and in America with the works of Harrigan and Hart. From 1940 to 1960, musicals experienced an era of absolute prosperity, which we call the "Golden Age of Musicals". In the middle of this era, the rock musical, the jukebox musical, the animated musical and many more developed.
